

## **Fire Safety House**

The fire safety house is a 36-foot long trailer that provides emergency prevention and preparedness training to the public. It was purchased with the help of a grant received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Thanks to this generous grant we are equipped with a tool that allows us to reinforce emergency training to the public. One aspect of this training is EDITH – Exit Drills In The Home. People can practice crawling low in a smoke filled atmosphere, feel a hot door and escape through a window to safety. The FSH also contains a Severe Weather Training Module that simulates a storm condition outside. This training is designed to teach the public how to prepare for severe weather and what to do when it arrives.

### ***Scheduling - Fire Safety House:***

- 1. All appearances must be approved and scheduled by calling Tonya Woods at 266-2533 Ext 26*
- 2. A minimum of three weeks advanced notice is required for booking the fire safety house.*
- 3. The fire safety house must be booked for a minimum of 4 hours.*
- 4. There must be adequate roadway ingress and egress for the 36' fire safety house and tow vehicle.*
- 5. It will take approximately 15-20 minutes per group of 20 (children or adults) to receive fire safety education and to successfully tour the house.*
- 6. In the event of inclement weather, the HBFD reserves the right to postpone, cancel, and/or reschedule the event.*
